Covid-19 Protocols before Holy Communion and at the end of Mass



Now that the pews have been returned to use in the church, we must work together to observe the safe-return to church practices that other parishes have been observing. Safe numbers (i.e. limited seating), as well as the following:

When coming forward for Holy Communion, you must be wearing your mask.

• Currently, we are only able to distribute Holy Communion on the palm of your bare hand.

 In order to maintain physical distancing, we will give holy communion to one side of the church at a time, starting on the tabernacle side first. Please use the markings on the main aisle to maintain physical distancing and return to your pew by way of the side aisle.

 If you are receiving the Eucharist please stop at the floor marker that is six feet from the priest or

Minister of Holy Communion.

 While wearing mask, the priest will say "The Body of Christ" and you will reply "Amen." With your mask on, approach the priest or Minister of Holy Communion. Allow the priest or minister to place the host on the palm of your bare hand.

 Then move to the spot marked on the floor to your left or right, remove your mask and consume the Eucharist. Then put the mask back on your face and return to your pew. Please do not walk and consume the Eucharist.

 If you are receiving a blessing, please cross your arms over your chest and receive the blessing from the 6 feet physical distancing floor marker.

Then you can return to your seat.

After the final dismissal and blessing, starting with the last row of pews on the Tabernacle side, working our way to the front of the church people will leave one row at a time. Starting at the front pew, people can exit the church via the parking lot and Markanna Drive doors at the front of the church. Please exit the church promptly. Once one side is gone, the rear of the other side will exit in the same way. Please be patient as we exit the church in a safe and responsible way.

 Please do not come to church if you have a Fever; Cough; Difficulty Breathing; Soar Throat and Trouble Swallowing; Runny Nose; Loss of Taste or Smell; Not Feeling Well; Nausea, Vomiting and Di-

arrhea.

Please follow the instructions of our ushers, as we adjust to the safety procedures in our church.


