DECEMBER 6 2020 2ND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

CYCLE A (MATTHEW)

I arrived at St. Boniface Parish on August 27th during the pandemic restrictions, but not in the total lockdown that we are now in. During all this time I have been anxiously awaiting the day when we can celebrate the joy of our faith together, freely and openly without masks or physical distancing.

Here we are now in the Advent Season, a time of waiting and of hopeful expectation of the coming of our Lord into this wounded world. It is so important for us to remember this now. Jesus came into an afflicted world to pronounce a new and divine truth, that the things that afflict us are passing away with his coming.

In the first reading for the Second Sunday of Advent, the prophet Isaiah proclaims, "Comfort, O comfort my people, says your God". How are we to be comforted in a time of such discomfort? Which is the better way to go? Shall we continue in social and economic lockdown, and people face the loss of their jobs, their incomes and cope with so many emotional and financial hardships? Or shall we end the lockdowns and let only those people who have the strength and natural immunity survive the pandemic? Both scenarios present hardship and loss of some kind. There seems to be no comfort in this kind of dilemma.

Yet Isaiah cries out, "In the wilderness prepare the way of the lord, make straight in the desert a highway for our God". Whatever the times we live in, we must not let our waiting grow cold and insensitive or fall into dormant inactivity. Advent is a time to hone our waiting skills, and this pandemic has presented us with a situation we can look at either way. We can fall into neglectful abandonment, being pulled along by troubling situations but not really trying. Or we can practice attentive waiting, looking for God's presence in those near us and reaching out to those who may need help with their waiting. There are many who are experiencing loneliness, isolation and depression in our times who will benefit from your kindness.

I pray that we are all able to appreciate the challenging context of facing the struggles of life and keeping faith. Jesus' divine presence among us was proclaimed by the prophet Isaiah, confirmed by John the Baptist and anointed with the power of the Holy Spirit. We are living in a period that calls us to a new attention. It is a real opportunity to embrace what Jesus' coming means for us. We go where life takes us, and we pray that God's providence and our faith will carry us through the things that are so averse to human life - always remembering Jesus' promise to be with us in all our lives. You are in my prayers every day. Fr. Peter.
