

# JANUARY 10 2021 BAPTISM OF THE LORD

CYCLE B (MATTHEW)

#### **FR. PETER'S REFLECTION**

The moment of focus in today's gospel is very clear. The gospel proclaims, "In those days Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee". Just as John the Baptist was proclaiming repentance and declaring, "The one who is more powerful that I is coming after me; I am not worthy to stoop down and untie the thong of his sandals. I have baptized you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit", just then Jesus appears on the scene revealing God's purpose in him.

Our Lord's hidden life takes place in Nazareth of Galilee. Jesus leaves his home town and comes to receive John's baptism. He has no need to receive this baptism of conversion. However, it was appropriate that Jesus, who was going to establish the New Covenant of mercy for repentance and conversion, should recognize and accept the mission of his Precursor by being baptized with John's baptism. This would encourage all people to prepare to receive the Baptism which is necessary.

The Fathers of the Church comment that our Lord went to receive John's baptism in order to fulfil all righteousness (cf. Mt 3:15), to give us an example of humility, to become widely known, to have people believe in him and to give life-giving strength to the waters of Baptism. Jesus himself is the fount of cleansing purity for the forgiveness of sins that John is proclaiming.

The moment of focus is clear. It is a time of starting something new. Every one of us is offered a new chance to live in God's love by our baptism into the merciful love of the Body of Christ. It has been a challenge in this New Year 2021; are we willing to welcome the good news of Jesus? One thing we can celebrate in our parish community is that Cardinal Collins has given permission for Sunday communion services so that people can stay connected with the central mystery of our faith -Jesus feeding, nourishing and giving us life in his Body and Blood in the Eucharist. Jesus has given us something new to celebrate. Whether we are at home or elsewhere, let us come together in whatever ways we can, and always stay with Jesus in his Word, in prayer and in the Eucharist.

# DID YOU KNOW?

#### WHAT IS THE LITURGUCAL YEAR (THE CHURCH YEAR)?

The liturgical year, or the Church year, superimposes the mysteries of the life of Christ - from His Incarnation to His second coming in glory - on the normal course of the year. The liturgical year begins with Advent, the time of waiting for the Lord, and has its high point in the Christmas season and its second, even greater climax in the celebration of the redemptive suffering, death, and Resurrection of Christ at Easter.

The Easter season ends with the feast of Pentecost, the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Church. The liturgical year is repeatedly interrupted by feasts of the Lord, Mary, and the saints, in which the Church praises God's grace, which has led mankind to salvation.
