## COMMUNION SERVICE AT ST. BONIFACE CHURCH

Immediately after the conclusion of the service, they shall exit from the side door in order to accommodate the next group of parishioners. This permission has been granted because His Eminence recognizes how important the Eucharist is, as the source and summit of our spiritual strength as Christians.
