EASTER MESSAGE FROM FR. PETER

We have been through a lot since March of 2020 when the first round of the pandemic changed the patterns and routines of everyone's lives. Who could have understood the world changing journey we were about to embark on. This is an opportunity to recall the image of God's chosen people on their journey in the desert for fourty years. They did not understand the journey God was leading them on. And it is worth noting that they let God know they were not happy, complaining many times throughout their epic journey. But God kept his promise and brought them to their new homeland. We must remember these biblical lessons: We don't always understand the pathways God is leading us on. But they are always the passageways to the rest that God wants for his children, and the homeland God wants his people.

This Easter we are in round six of the covid variants, and we're winning. The effect of the illness is weaker, and our freedom to return to normal living is increasing. We remember and grieve the losses we have seen and experienced. We have much to pray for in the conflicts and troubles that still affect the world. But we know that we have a Saviour who has conquered all for us, we are winning. Now we know the journey we are on more clearly. We are already saved by the love of God poured out in Jesus and the ultimate victory of his resurrection. And we can celebrate and share his love with everyone on our journey, every day of our lives. Happy Easter to you all!

welcome to attend.




DID YOU KNOW?

Are there proofs for the Resurrection of Jesus?

There are no proofs for the Resurrection of Jesus in the scientific sense. There are, however, very strong individual and collective testimonies by a large number contemporaries of those events in Jerusalem.

The oldest written testimony to the Resurrection is a letter that St. Paul wrote to the Corinthians around twenty years after Christ's death: "...He was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures, and that He appeared to Cephas, then to the Twelve. Then He appeared to more than five hundred brethren at one time, most whom are still alive..." (1 Cor.15:3-6) Paul is recording here a living tradition that was present in the original Christian community two or three years after Jesus' death and Resurrection, when he himself became a Christian - on the basis of his own staggering encounter with the risen Lord. The disciples took the fact of the empty tomb as the first indication of the reality of the Resurrection. Women, of all people, discovered it - according to the law of that time they were not able to testify. The Apostle John - "saw and believed".
