

MARCH 31, 2024 **EASTER SUNDAY RESURRECTION OF THE LORD** CYCLE B (MARK)

EASTER MESSAGE FROM FR. PETER

In his pastoral letter "Seeking the Kingdom of God Above and Beyond All Other Things", Archbishop Leo talks about how each of us is called to show others the Kingdom revealed to us by Jesus, "more fully, intentionally and responsibly with all our heart...". The Archbishop is very refreshing in that he identifies the qualities of Jesus' kingdom as being one of Truth, Life, Holiness and Grace, Justice, Love, and Peace. And while our archdiocese is involved in all of these ways, working to bring this kingdom into the midst of our lives, he also notes that there are both people and institutional aspects among us that do not do this, or who even contradict what Jesus has revealed and demands of his disciples and his church. In all of this, Archbishop Leo reminds us that we are not alone. We are surrounded by a cloud of witnesses, the saints, mystics, martyrs and holy souls who have witnessed to Jesus before us and continually intercede for us.

Pope Francis also emphasises that we must follow this holy path: "Reading the Scriptures also makes it clear that the Gospel is not merely about our personal relationship with God. Nor should our loving response to God be seen simply as an accumulation of small personal gestures to individuals in need... or a series of acts aimed solely at easing our conscience. The Gospel is about the kingdom of God (Lk 4:43); it is about loving God who reigns in our world. To the extent that he reigns within us, the life of society will be a setting for universal fraternity, justice, peace and dignity. Both Christian preaching and life, then are meant to have an impact on society" (Evangelii Gaudium, 80).

In his message for World Day of Vocations, Pope Francis also says that "Our life finds fulfillment when we discover who we are, what our gifts are, where we can make them bear fruit, and what path we can follow in order to become signs and instruments of love generous acceptance, beauty and peace, wherever we find ourselves".

Today we celebrate that Jesus is risen. He has conquered death and promised to overcome every form of evil for us. Let us begin anew and in earnest to joyfully live the kingdom Jesus victoriously proclaimed and has inaugurated with his resurrection.

DID YOU KNOW?

Through his Resurrection, did Jesus return to the physical, corporeal state that he had during his earthly life?

The risen Lord allowed his disciples to touch him; he ate with them and showed them the wounds of his Passion. Nevertheless, his body belonged no longer only to this earth, but rather to the heavenly kingdom of his Father.

The risen Christ, who bore the wounds of the Crucified, was no longer bound by space and time. He could enter through locked doors and appear to his disciples in various places in a form in which they did not recognize him immediately. Christ's Resurrection was, therefore, not a return to a normal earthly life, but rather his entrance into a new way of being: "For we know that Christ being raised from the dead will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him" (Rom 6:9).


