promised land, the kingdom of heaven. Like Amos in today's First Reading, the Apostles are not "professionals" who earn their bread by prophesy- ing. Like Amos, they are simply men (see <u>Acts</u> <u>14:15</u>) summoned from their ordinary jobs and sent by God to be shepherds of their brothers and sis- ters. Again this week, we hear the theme of rejec- tion: Amos experiences it, and Jesus warns the Apostles that some will not welcome or listen to them. The Church is called not necessarily to be successful but only to be faithful to God's command. With authority and power given to her by Jesus, the Church proclaims God's peace and salvation to those who believe in Him, as we sing in today's Psalm. This word of truth, this Gospel of salvation, is addressed to each of us, personally, as Paul pro- claims in today's Epistle. In the mystery of God's will, we have been chosen from before the founda- tion of the world—to be His sons and daughters, to live for the praise of His glory. Let us, then, give thanks for the Church today, and for the spiritual blessings He has bestowed upon us. Let us resolve to further the Church's mission—to help others hear the call to repentance and welcome Christ into their lives.
